## **5. Chairman's Report**

Cllr Hicks reported on the previous year's activities and thanked those who had supported the parish council with beach-related matters including District Cllr Grimes.

## **6. Speed Indicator Device in Brean**

A number of residents and members of the parish council put forward views on the merits of the village purchasing a Speed Indicator Device to support the request to manage the issue of speeding within Brean.

It was agreed by the majority of residents present that they would like the parish council to pursue the option of purchasing a SID and the matter would come back to the parish council on a future agenda to take a decision.

## **7. Matters brought forward by registered electors of Brean Parish Council**

Matters relating to the ongoing management of the beach by Sedgemoor District Council from April 2022 were brought forward by residents. It was noted that the management of the beach would pass to the new unitary authority from April 2023
