The formal session starts at 7.00pm and there is an opportunity for parishioners to address the council during public participation in the meeting.

◆ Bus shelters & bench

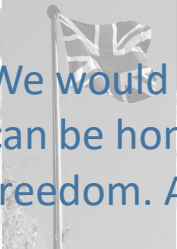

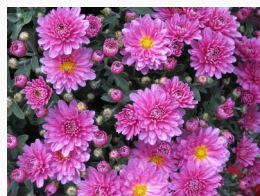
◆ Notice boards & Existing Shelters

The Parish Council does not have an abundance of land, therefore, to cater for those of all ages, those with dementia, & autism, the idea of an eco-environment with sensory attributes garden would fit the criteria. This creates a place for the whole community's health and well-being as well as being educational. And a sensational garden for the village to enjoy for years to come.

A plan was drawn as to what it will look like and various contractors were consulted. Eventually, the funding application was put in.
